



I think the big ideas project would be much more useful as an individual project with slightly smaller scope. This would also lessen the stress of having to coordinate two separate group projects throughout the entire semester (it really is so hard to consistently meet with a group especially towards the end of the semester. In terms of teaching, Steven is truly a wonderful teacher and as a student, i really feel like he cares about my learning and experience in the classroom. I was genuinely surprised that he considered our feedback and made adjustments to the course almost immediately (this has never happened before for me and it was so nice!!).
